Goal:

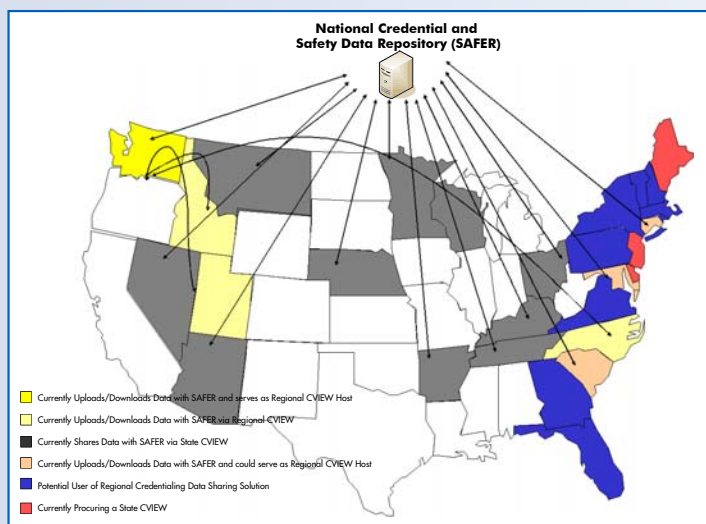

Deliverables:

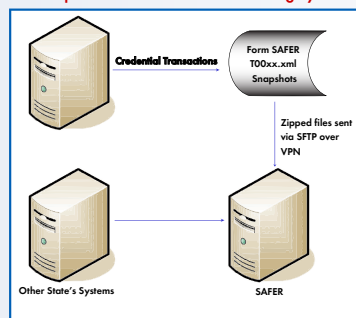
- Deployment options made available to states interested in expediting the sharing of credentials data

Deployment of Credential Data Exchange Solution:

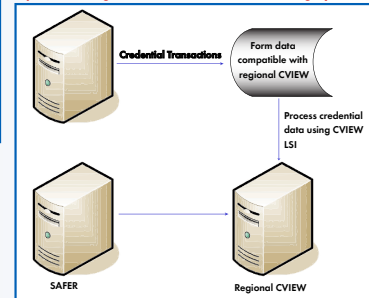
- Improves the efficiencies of administrative and enforcement processes and the economic viability of commercial vehicle operations in the I-95 Corridor
- Improves highway safety and freight mobility for commercial and passenger vehicles in the I-95 Corridor
- Short-term solution to credentials data exchange among states
- CVSN Level One Compliance for participating states
- Member states recognize the full value of currently deployed systems and infrastructure



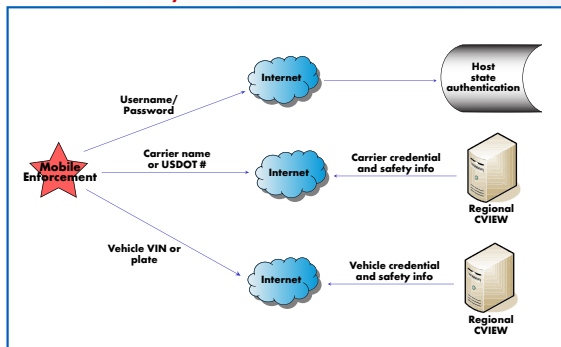
Direct Upload to SAFER Via Credentialing Systems



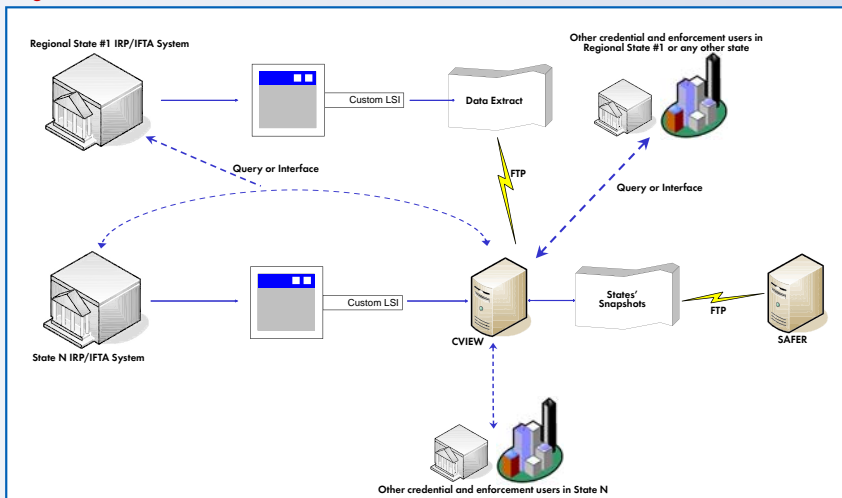
Upload to Regional CVIEW Via Credentialing Systems
